

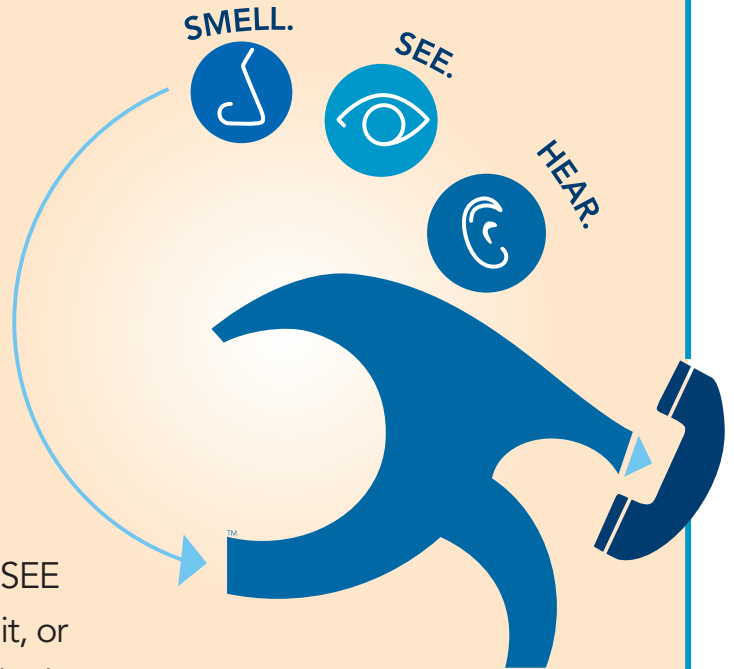


# BE A NATURAL GAS SAFETY WHIZ KID!

## HERE'S HOW...

**ALWAYS** remember the three signs of a natural gas leak:

- **SMELL** — To help you SMELL a leak, natural gas companies add a chemical that smells like rotten eggs.
- **SEE** — Near a gas leak, you might SEE blowing dirt, water with bubbles in it, or an area of dead plants surrounded by live ones.
- **HEAR** — A leaking pipe might make a hissing sound you can HEAR.



## IF YOU EVER SMELL, SEE OR HEAR a NATURAL GAS LEAK:

1. Tell a grown-up right away!
2. Leave the area quickly and don't touch or use anything electric on your way out—not even a light switch or telephone.
3. Don't return until the natural gas company says it's safe.
